

Let's Learn Lingala

The main local language of western Congo is Lingala [leen-GAH-lah]. Vowels are pronounced as follows: *ah* as in father; *eh* as in better; *ee* as bee; *ih* as in him; *oh* as in boat; *oo* as in boot.
